

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MATURE Making Adult Teaching Useful, Relevant and Engaging

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
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What is MATURE?

MATURE stands for Making Adult Teaching Useful, Relevant and Engaging. It is a Grundtvig multilateral project co-funded by the European Commission's Lifelong Learning programme. The project began in October 2012 and ends in September 2014. It will develop training for adult educators on the theme of engaging and motivating older adults who, because of disadvantage, find it difficult to participate in group learning. The MATURE team will: conduct research; develop and deliver units of training for face to face and on-line use; create a booklet for organisations outside education who act in as intermediaries between older adults and the services they need or are entitled to.
