4	Uphagen's House	<p>Bought in 1775 by Johann Uphagen, the town house was completely rebuilt by the master builder Johannim Beniemin Dreyer.</p> <p>Uphagen's House is a reminder of the former greatness of Gdańsk. 5	Golden Gate	<p>The gate is a mix of Flemish and Italian styles and since its reconstruction and renovation it has served as a symbol of the city as a whole. There are several figures on a top of the gate.
